Requirements for Entering School

The Board of Education of New Milford requires the following as a prerequisite for all students entering the school district.

1. **Proof of Complete Immunizations** which include:

- a) **DTP/DT/Td** - 4 doses with one given on or after the 4th birthday 3 doses in a child over the age of seven starting the series
- b) **Polio vaccine**- 3 doses with the last dose given after the 4th birthday 3 doses in a child over the age of seven starting the series. Any 4 doses regardless of age
- c) **Measles**- 2 doses given after the 1st birthday
- d) **Mumps**- 1 dose after the 1st birthday
- e) **Rubella**- 1 dose after the 1st birthday
- f) **Hepatitis B**- completed series of 3 doses minimum 28 days between 1st & 2nd, minimum 56 days between 2nd & 3rd
- g) **Varicella**- 1 dose after the first birthday or after 1/1/98 on or after the first birthday **OR** proof of the disease
- h) **Flu shot as of December 1st.**
- i) **HIB** - vaccine required for children in child care and preschool under age 59 months given on or after the 1st birthday
- j) **Lead Screening**- required of all preschool children

2. **Physical Examination**- done prior to entering school

3. **Mantoux Test**- for Tuberculosis if the student is entering from out of country or from a required area

4. **Emergency card**- completed

Failure to provide the school with this information (within 30 days from the day of entrance) may cause the student to be excluded from school until proper proof of the required health information is received.
