At your senior portrait sitting our photographers will take numerous poses in appropriate attire (please see below) on our traditional blue background. Below are the listing of photo dates & times.

Please arrive a few minutes prior to your scheduled time and you must arrive dressed with proper attire for photo session.

- **Boys:** recommended: wear a suit jacket, tie and white dress shirt.
 - We recommend a solid color jacket in Dark Colors, Black/Gray/Navy

Girls: recommended: a school appropriate dress or blouse-Dark Colors, Black/Gray/Navy. We recommend simple earrings and a necklace if choosing to wear jewelry.

- **Please no street wear: t-shirts, sweatshirts, etc.**
- **Cap & Gown :**
 - Unfortunately, due to the spread of COVID-19 Rod Bolten photography will not be able to provide cap and gowns this year. However, you may bring your own or borrow one from a friend or family member if you wish to take cap & gown portraits at this time. We will be working with every school to reschedule and take your c & g portraits at a later time if you wish to have them done. We apologize for the inconvenience, but your safety is our number one priority.

COVID-19 Guidelines for Senior Portraits



Please make sure to check the front of your appointment letter for yearbook attire requirements. We appreciate your understanding. Please keep in mind that we will always follow strict sanitation guidelines, implement several additional safety recommendations from the local, state and federal governments designed to combat the spread of COVID-19 and make every student and our team members feel completely confident in our ability to provide a safe environment. Should you want more information about our safety measures, please feel free to contact our customer service team.

For the safety of the students and their families, Rod Bolten Photography will be taking the following precautionary measures at all schools and studios:

- Employees will be wearing masks at all times

 - Proper social distancing will be maintained between our photographers and any other students

 - One student per photographer will be allowed in the photography area at the same time

 - Only one parent or legal guardian will be allowed with the student and both must be wearing a mask upon entering location.

 - Student's temperature will be checked at check-in table upon arriving

 - Any items that a student comes in contact with will be sanitized prior to any student that follows
 - All surfaces will be sanitized before and after every student

 - Hand sanitizing stations will be available for student / photographer use

 - We encourage you to bring your own props to show your personality (instrument, sports equipment, varsity jacket, hobbies, etc)

FOR OUR SAFETY

For the safety of Rod Bolten Photography and school staff, students should please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Please show up on time to your appt. to keep the school and photography area to safe numbers
- Do not enter the building/photography room prior to your appointment time
- Wash your hands prior to your session
- Masks must be worn upon arrival and when departing the photography area
- Maintain proper social distancing between photographers and other students
- Do not schedule or attend an appointment if you have travelled to a state on the NJ travel advisory list within two weeks prior to your appointment. Please cancel your scheduled session if the list changes and this is the case.
- Please keep in mind that in order to stop the spread and to keep everyone safe, **Rod Bolten photography will not be providing any kind of garment outfits to students this year.**
