School Psychologist

What are the responsibilities of the School Psychologist?

The school psychologist has expertise in determining a child's level of cognitive and conceptual development. In addition, the psychologist is concerned with the emotional status of the student, and how both internal and external factors may affect behavior and performance in school. The school psychologist works with both general education and special education teachers to maximize a student's potential. School psychologists help students succeed academically, socially, behaviorally, and emotionally. They collaborate with educators, parents, and other professionals, to create safe and supportive learning environments that strengthen connections between home, school and the community for all students.

School psychologists are employed by the school as members of Child Study Team. Each school psychologist has a minimum of a Master's Degree in Psychology.
