COURSE

This AP English Literature and Composition course adheres to College Board guidelines and is designed and taught thematically with an emphasis on core readings along with modern and contemporary selections that illuminate and expand upon a variety of themes. We will address the fundamentals of literary analysis and introductory college composition. Each week students will discuss and engage in a variety of writing activities focusing on argumentation, interpretation, analysis, rhetorical strategies, exposition, structure, and style. Students read and study a variety of novels, plays, poems, and short stories from the 16th century to the present.

COURSE MATERIALS:

Students will be provided with all texts & course materials needed for the course. However, students should have a designated class binder to store & organize all materials.

ESSAY HARD COPIES

Most essays are required to be typed & submitted as BOTH a digital document (on the assigned Google Doc) AND turned In as a hard copy. These hard copies MUST be submitted at the start of class on the due dates. You will not have time to print out copies at the beginning of class. Please use the free school printing services (FollowMe Print) In the school library.
